Beginning in 7th grade, we empower our scholars to emerge as a collective of lifelong leaders in service of powerful change by providing them with preparation, access, and support throughout a transformative educational journey.

From 7th grade through college, we:

- Recruit high performing, high potential, underserved students from St. Louis City
- Prepare them for a rigorous high school education
- Provide scholars with access to top college preparatory high schools
- Support scholars in realizing ongoing academic success in high school
- Support scholars in applying, selecting, and succeeding in a four-year college of their choice
- Empower scholars to emerge as leaders in their high schools, colleges and communities

Selection Criteria

Student must currently be in 7th grade, must be a resident of St. Louis City, and must attend a St. Louis Public or charter school in St. Louis City. We look for students who meet most or all of the following criteria:

- Strong academic performance preferably 6th and 7th grade GPA of at least 3.2
- Strong performance on MAP tests preferably Proficient or Advanced in both Math and Communication Arts
- Two teacher recommendations that indicate the student is diligent, hardworking, and of high character
- Four student essays demonstrating knowledge, character, and leadership

The first part of the interview involves candidates working in a group with other young people. The second part of the interview involves the candidate participating in an individual interview.
