Outdoor Play



OBJECTIVE

To provide flexible, unstructured outdoor play opportunities that encourage movement, creativity, and social interaction through self-directed exploration.

FOCUS & SKILLS DEVELOPED

- Physical Activity
- Creativity

SUPPLIES

- Varies by rental but could include Frisbees, Cones, Hula Hoops, Various types and sizes of balls, and other open-play equipment as available.

SETUP

- This activity is intentionally open-ended and does not follow a single set of rules.
- Participants may use materials individually or in small groups.
- Equipment may be used in multiple ways based on group interest and space.

OPENING BRIEF

Outdoor Open Play invites participants to move, explore, and play in ways that feel right for them. There is no single goal or game—participants are encouraged to use the materials creatively, try new ideas, and enjoy being active outdoors.

ACTIVITY OPTIONS

Participants may choose one or more of the following approaches, or create their own:

- Free play with any available equipment
- Create simple games or challenges using cones, hoops, or balls
- Practice skills such as throwing, catching, balancing, or kicking
- Play cooperatively or independently based on preference
- Combine materials to invent new ways to move or play

There is no required structure; groups are encouraged to adapt play to their energy level and interests.

SAFETY NOTE

- Be aware of others sharing the play space.
- Use equipment as intended and pause play if areas become crowded.
- Adjust activities as needed to keep play safe and inclusive.

CLEAN-UP/RETURN INSTRUCTIONS

- Collect all equipment and return items to their containers.
- Check the surrounding grounds for any stray items before returning equipment.
- Return all materials to staff at the designated return location.
