Arts & Crafts

Unleash creativity with self-led projects that provide all the materials and instructions you need to design, decorate, and make something uniquely your own.

Collaborative group canvas	Work together to add colors, shapes, and ideas to a shared canvas, creating a one-of-a-kind artwork as a group.	\$35
Friendship bracelet kit	Create colorful woven bracelets using simple knotting techniques.	\$10
Nature Prints	Create art by rubbing crayons on paper over natural textures or nature-themed plates, capturing unique patterns from the outdoors.	\$20
Origami kit	Create decorative shapes, animals, and objects through the Japanese art of paper folding.	\$10
Potted bead plants	Design a colorful "plant" using beads and wire in a small decorative pot.	\$30
Rock Painting	Paint smooth rocks with designs or messages using paint pens and/or brushes.	\$25
Scent Diffusers	Decorate a container and fill it with essential oils to create your own personalized scent diffuser. Recommended for ages 12+, though supervision is highly suggested at any age.	\$35
Stick and yarn weaving	Wrap colorful yarn around two crossed sticks to create a vibrant woven decoration.	\$10
Zine kit	Create a mini-book from folded paper and decorate with drawings and texts.	\$20

Nature Exploration

Explore the outdoors at your own pace with self-led activities and instructions that spark curiosity about aquatic life, forests, the sky, and local wildlife.

Aquatic	Make observations using five senses and tools as you explore water ecosystems on campus. <i>Activities are seasonal and weather-dependent.</i> Package choices include: Observation and/or Bingo.	\$10
Forest	Use the five senses to observe the forest setting and locate items as they move around the campus grounds. <i>Activities are seasonal and weather-dependent.</i> Package choices include: Bingo and/or Scavenger hunt.	\$5
Hiking	Follow marked trails at your own pace to experience the sights, sounds, and natural beauty of camp. Each hike includes a camp map with Leave No Trace reminders to guide your journey.	FREE
Sky	Use your eyes and simple tools to explore the sky by identifying cloud formations during the day or learning constellations at night. <i>Activities are seasonal and weather-dependent.</i> Package choices include: Cloud Identification and/or Constellation Study.	\$5

Backyard Games

Enjoy classic outdoor games that bring groups together for friendly competition and fun in the open air.

Cornhole	Toss beanbags onto a raised board and aim for the hole to score points.	\$25
Giant Jenga	Giant version of classic block-stacking game. Remove blocks one by one and try not to topple the tower.	\$15
Ladder Toss	Toss bolas onto a ladder-style stand, scoring points based on where they land.	\$25
Tic-Tac-Toe Toss	A twist on the classic paper and pencil game. Toss to claim squares and be the first to get three in a row.	\$15
Washers	Toss metal washers toward a target box and try to land them in the cup for the most points.	\$15

Campfire activities

Enjoy classic outdoor games that bring groups together for friendly competition and fun in the open air.

Campfire (w/S'mores)	A cozy campfire prepared and put out by staff, with the option to add S'mores for a sweet treat.	\$2.5 per person
Ember Messages	Write a reflection, intention, or hope on an "ember card," then place it into a collection box for an adult to add to the fire—sending your message into the sky. A meaningful ritual for transitions, goal-setting, or closing the day. This activity uses biodegradable paper.	\$5
S'mores stories	Build a story together by drawing pretend graham crackers, marshmallows, and chocolate—each with a story element to inspire your tale. A fun, creative twist to share around the fire.	\$5
Soundscapes	Use voices and body percussion to create a layered, nature-inspired soundscape around the fire, guided by simple prompts like crickets, rain, or thunder.	FREE

Creative Construction

Use building pieces to design, stack, and create imaginative structures in this open-ended, hands-on activity.

Brain Flakes	Interlocking discs that snap together to build colorful 2D and 3D shapes, encouraging creativity and spatial thinking.	\$15
Lego	Classic bricks for building imaginative models and structures while promoting creativity and problem-solving.	\$20
